<u>We will be learning about</u>

The topic for the Summer Term is "Raging River"



We are going to explore the UK and the world learning about how rivers are formed, erosion and deposition. Ash Class will be making their own rivers. Also, we will be learning about the effects of climate change and pollution.

In Science we will focus on river and coastal habitats. How have organisms adapted to their environment? How do they depend on each other in their ecosystem? Ash Class will learn about the work of David Attenborough and Jane Goodall.



We will also learn about the importance of water in industry and hydropower.



In Design Technology the children will face the boat race challenge. Who can design the quickest boat that floats?



In RE we will learn about 'Our World' and explore creation stories.

PE and Games Lessons

Ash class will participate in PE sessions led by school staff. We will be participating in both indoor and outdoor activites. Children are asked to bring their full P.E. kit to school on a Monday. Then take it home every Friday for washing. For our outdoor P.E. lessons, it is important that children have warm clothing (tracksuit bottoms and a sweatshirt) as well as shorts, a t-shirt and trainers. Girls who wear tights should bring a pair of socks to keep in their P.E. bag. Earrings must be taken out for P.E. lessons or covered using tape. Please provide tape if you do not wish your child to take their earrings out.

In our music sessions we will all be 'Dancing in the Street'. I am sure you will know the song. Ash Class will be singing along, playing the glockenspiels and composing.
