KEEP ON KEEPING OUR SCHOOL A TRAFFIC FREE ZONE!

Thank you to everyone who continues to keep our school a traffic free zone. The drop off and pick up times are so much easier. Let's continue what we have started & make the journey to and from school safer.

For the safety of all I politely ask that you DO NOT drive in front of school or park on Grange Road at drop off and pick up times. Thank you!

Drop Off & Pick Up Arrangements

Where possible, please try to ensure that only 1 adult per household drops off and collects children from school.

Adults are encouraged to wear masks.

It is very important that children arrive on time for their sessions and are picked up promptly to enable social distancing to take place. We recognise that some families will be dropping children off & collecting at different entrances. Please do not panic! Staff will remain at all gates to welcome & say goodbye to children.

Please note, we also ask parents & carers not to socialise at the school gates for social distancing.

What to Bring to School

Classes will not be using cloakrooms, except Acorn Class. Children will keep their lunchboxes with them in the classroom and put their coats on the backs of their chairs.

Please DO NOT send:

- PE Kit (children will come to school in PE kits on the days they will be doing PE. Class teachers will tell you this via seesaw)
- Bikes / scooters – we cannot accommodate these
- Bags / pencil cases / toys etc.

P.E. Sessions

- Our PE sessions will take place outside
- On PE days, children should come to school in PE kit as changing facilities are restricted
- PE Kit – school PE t-shirt, black shorts (in hot weather!), black joggers, trainers, school sweatshirt / cardigan
- Teachers will send details of PE sessions via seesaw

Leconfield Stars Breakfast & After School Clubs

- Our Breakfast and After School Clubs will be open from Monday 12th April.
- Drop off & Collection is from the gate next to the horses' field – PLEASE RING THE BELL!
- Breakfast Club opens at 7.30am
- Drop off at horses' field gate – a member of staff will collect your child from you and sign them in. Parents & carers must not come on to site.
- Breakfast is served at 8.00am. Children who want breakfast must be on site by 8.00am.
- After School Club closes promptly at 5.00pm. Parents and carers can collect any time until 5.00pm. A charge will be made for late collections.
- Children will be in their daily class bubbles when attending the clubs. Both clubs will be in the main hall and each class bubble will have their own area

We will not take children who are not booked in.

School Lunches

Children may bring a packed lunch or order a school sandwich meal.

School Sandwich meals include a choice of sandwich filling (ham, cheese or tuna mayo), carrot & cucumber sticks, a homemade treat (cupcake / tray bake), a piece of fruit, yoghurt, water or milk.

- Infant meals are funded.
- KS2 meals cost £2.40 via ParentPay

Hygiene

Regular hand washing will be timetabled into the school day for all our children.

We have hand sanitising stations in all classrooms and all rooms have sinks, soap and disposable paper towels for hand washing. All classrooms have hygiene stations so staff can regularly clean tables and equipment throughout the day.

All toilets have hand wash facilities and classes have their own toilets and sinks.

Illness

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19 they must stay at home and you should arrange a test as soon as possible. Please let us know the results of the test as soon as you have them. Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell.

Lateral Flow Testing for Families

The government has home test kits available to all families of school age children.

Staff in school have been taking part in regular lateral flow testing. We strongly encourage you to take part in the testing as another way to keep our community safe and our school open.

I know there are some concerns about the accuracy of these tests and families might be worried they will be told to isolate unnecessarily. Rest assured, if you receive a positive result from a LFD test you should book a PCR test at a local site for the household. *If the PCR test returns negative for the household, the isolation can stop and you will be able to send your child to school.*
