<u>English</u>

<u>Maths</u>

Also, everyday we solve a maths problem of the day and share our calculation methods during our number talk time.

PSHE

<u>Art & Design</u>

In Art and Design, we will be 'Growing artists' as we develop our drawing and observation skills. Then after half term we will focus on painting as we create prehistoric cave paintings.



<u>Science</u>

Our budding scientists this term will be learning about scientific enquiry as we investigate rocks, forces and magnets.

<u>French</u>
