Dear Parents and Carers,

### Mobile Phones

We understand mobile phones provide necessary reassurance if children are walking to and from school alone. Children should only bring phones into school if they are walking to and from school unaccompanied. For reasons of safety and to make sure phones are not lost or damaged phones must be handed in to the main office on arrival at school. Phones must be collected from the office at 3.30pm. Phones will be kept securely in the school office during the school day.

### Clothing for PE

It is important that children are dressed correctly for PE. Long hair must be tied back and earrings taken out or covered with tape. Please provide a roll of tape for your child if they cannot take their earrings out. On PE days, children should wear the school logo PE shirt and black joggers, leggings or shorts. Children should also wear their school logo jumper, cardigan or school logo hoodie. Appropriate footwear should be worn – trainers are ideal. Children take off their shoes and socks for some PE lessons, e.g. gymnastics, dance. This is so they can move safely and grip when using the apparatus. Please send us a message on seesaw if there is any reason your child cannot work in bare feet.

### Parking Issues

Over the last few weeks we have had several comments from different people about dangerous parking at drop off and pick up times.
