Road Safety

A small number of children are forgetting to wear their helmets when riding or scooting to school. Please make sure children wear their cycle helmets so they are protected in case of an accident.

Parking & Traffic Concerns

A few weeks ago in the newsletter I talked about the frustrations of local residents and parents with the parking at drop off and pick up times. I know so many of you are worried about this issue and feel an accident is inevitable if things don't change. A member of our community reached out to the local authority to see if they can offer any support and received the following information:

Thank you for contacting the Traffic Management team on the 17th April 2024 regarding the Parking on Arram Road, Leconfield.

There are currently no parking restrictions on Arram Road, so cars are parking legally and we would be unable to enforce at this location at this time. However, we would be able to investigate implementing 'no waiting restrictions' on Arram Road but we would this require a strong level of community support. We would request that in the first instance, you take this matter up with your Parish Council. If they are in agreement, then they can take this matter up with us on your behalf.

In the meantime, we do encourage all members of the public to report motoring offences—such as speeding or unsafe driving—to the police. You can now conveniently submit video evidence through Operation Snap, a secure online platform. Its purpose is to enhance road safety and hold accountable those who jeopardize the well-being of others.
