The above information is for families of children with special educational needs and /or disabilities. The children do not have to have a formal diagnosis or EHCP but have an identified need.

The group is parent led by two SEND parents and is supported by professionals. There will be other services and professionals in attendance at the groups to offer advice and guidance around matters such as; available support, EHCP processes, school related challenges, specialist support and SEND social groups.

The neurodiversity service is attending the next group (4th February) as well as educational welfare. In March, the sensory processing service is joining the meetings.

Sam Wright, a family coordinator from Early Help, previously from the SEND 0-25 Team, will be supporting these sessions. Alongside her is Sym Tomlinson from health watch who will be available to answer any health-related questions. It is an opportunity for parents/carers to get together to share their lived experiences and gain valuable peer support. This is an informal, friendly group with no need to book in advance.
