About our school

Leconfield Primary School is in the East Riding of Yorkshire, just outside of a town called Beverley. Leconfield is in the countryside, not to far away from the coast of Bridlington and Hornsea.



Leconfield Primary School has around 150 children. It has the most military children in the East Riding of Yorkshire. Around half of the children in our school are from military families and half are not.

A day at Leconfield Primary School
